## **GEAR LINKAGE TO CHASSIS BUSH**

## **INSTALLATION GUIDE**

## **Contents (parts per pack):**

- 1 x Polyurethane A Bush
- 1 x Polyurethane B Bush
- 1 x Grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual.

It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

## **Fitting Instructions:**

- 1) Unbolt the linkage steady rod, lowering it down from the vehicle.
- 2) Press out the old rubber bush from the steady rod, retaining the OE washers and bolt and noting their orientation.
- 3) Clean the bore of the steady rod and any corrosion from the washers.
- 4) Push the larger PU top hat bush (63-416A) in from the gearbox side of the steady rod.
- 5) The thinner PU washer (63-416B) fits on the opposing side of the steady rod.
- 6) Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore of the bush and end faces.
- 7) Re-fit the linkage steady rod to the vehicle with the original washers and bolt, in the same orientation as they were removed.
- 8) Tension all hardware to the manufacturer's recommended torque settings
