

1. Remove the original rubber bush and outer shell from the front position of the rear trailing arm. Clean any dirt or corrosion from the bore in the support bracket.

2. Press the outer shell into the support bracket from the outside of the car until the larger diameter of the shell is against the arm.

3. Check the stainless steel sleeve is not in the bush. Press the polyurethane A bush into the outer shell from the inside of the car. Press the polyurethane B bush into the shell from the outside of the car.

4. Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore and both ends of the bush and insert the sleeve into the bush. Insert the sleeve into the bush with the chamfered edge facing towards the inside of the car into the casting.

5. Place the supplied washer onto the cast aluminium arm. This fits against the A part of the bush. The original domed washer fits into the B part of the bush.
