REAR TRAILING ARM BUSH

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

2 x Polyurethane A Bushes 1 x Grease

2 x Polyurethane B Bushes 2 x Stainless Steel Sleeves

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual.

It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.



Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the original bush from the trailing arm.
- 2. Clean out any dirt or corrosion from the bore of the arm.
- 3. Push both polyurethane parts into the arm with part A (larger lip) facing outside the vehicle.
- 4. Apply the supplied grease to the inside of the bore of the polyurethane bush and the end faces of the bushes.
- 5. Fit the metal sleeve inside the bore so that it sits flush inside.
- 6. Fit the arm back onto the vehicle and tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torque settings.




Figure 1 - diagram showing how the polyurethane parts fit the arm
