

1. Support the rear subframe. Loosen rear subframe bolts bolts and support washers to gain access to the subframe bushes. The subframe need only be lowered a small amount to insert the upper polyurethane inserts.

- 2. Clean any dirt or debris from around the rubber bush and voiding.
- 3. Fit insert A into the upper position of the rear subframe, front bush.
- 4. Fit insert B into the lower position of the rear subframe, front bush.
- 5. Fit insert C into the upper position of the rear subframe, rear bush.
- 6. Fit insert D into the lower position of the rear subframe, rear bush.

7. Refit the original washers to both lower bushes on the subframe and tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torque settings.
